History

The city of Modena was a Roman colony in 183 A.C. and in 43 A.C. was the stage of the battle between Decimo Bruto and Marco Antonio, which marked the rise of Octavius and the birth of the Second Triumvirate. The city was half destroyed during the 4th century, and abandoned in the 5th and 6th centuries but rose again at the time of the episcopacy; under the episcopal rule (8th-10th centuries) was able to enjoy imperial privileges and enter the sphere of influence of Canossa lords. It was in this climate that the 9th of June, 1099, the first stone of the Duomo was laid, giving birth to the masterpiece of



Romanesque art, designed by Lanfranco and now recognised by UNESCO as part of the universal heritage of mankind, along with the Ghirlandina tower and Piazza Grande. The Este family ruled from 1289 to 1306, from 1336 to 1520 and returned to the city again in 1527, after a period of imperial rule followed by papal rule. In 1598 the Court of Ferrara was transferred to Modena which thus became the capital and saw the rise of the new Ducal Palace (1634). From 1814 the Austro-Estense dukes, Francesco IV and Francesco V, ruled the State until 1859.

Getting to the Symposium Site

The city of Modena can be reached:

by car

coming from Genova through A7 Genova-Milan Highway connected with A1 Milan-Bologna (exit Modena Nord); coming from Torino through A21 Torino-Brescia Highway connected with A1 Milan-Bologna Highway (exit Modena Nord); coming from Milan through A1 Milan-Bologna Highway (exit Modena Nord); coming from Austria and Bolzano through A22 Brennero-Modena Highway connected with A1 Milan-Bologna (exit Modena Nord); coming from Slovenia, Croatia and Venice through A4 Trieste-Padova and A13 Padova-Bologna connected with A1 Bologna-Milan (exit Modena Sud);

by train

arriving at Modena railway station in Piazza Dante Alighieri where buses (N. 2 and 7) and taxis are available for transportation to the Congress Centre near the Policlinico Hospital;

by plane

flying to the G. Marconi Airport in Bologna (35 km from Modena) where you can find the shuttle bus service that connects Bologna Airport with Modena railway station.
